

ERROR in WINDOWS XP when trying to repair IP:

Failed to Query TCP/IP settings of the connection.
Cannot Proceed

Following fix worked:

Try resetting winsock.

I'm assuming you have SP2 installed. If not let me know and I'll give you a different workaround.

Click START then RUN. You will then see a box to type in. Delete whatever in in there and type CMD. Then click OK.

Type in

netsh winsock reset

Then press ENTER and restart your computer.

Next, repeat the first part of the previous step.

(Click START then RUN. You will then see a box to type in. Delete whatever in in there and type CMD. Then click OK.)

Type in :

netsh int ip reset c:\resetlog.txt

Then press ENTER and restart your computer again.

You should now be able to connect to your router.
