

Configure MAC OS X for wired router, DSL or WGB

Click

Apple menu (upper left corner of screen)

System preferences

Network

At location choose Add Location

Type name for location, click ok

Change show to Built in Ethernet

Click on TCP/IP Tab

Make sure is set to Configure using DHCP

Click apply and close

To check TCP/IP address on OS X

Click on hard drive (should be upper right hand corner)

Choose : applications folder, Utilities Folder, Network utilities.

On the first tab there is a drop down box for all the nic's go through them to see if any have valid ip address

There is a Ping and Trace Route tab you can click on to do either of these tests

Put address you want to test in "Host" and click ping or ?(not sure of name on traceroute screen) button
